## Chillicothe R-II Protocol for Returning Essential Employees

The Chillicothe R-II School District will abide by the Declaration of Essential Workers that was approved by the Livingston County Health Department on September 23, 2020. The Chillicothe R-II District has agreed to the following protocol when working with the local Declaration of Essential Workers:

- 1. The declaration has identified administrators, faculty and staff of all Livingston County Schools as Essential Critical Infrastructure Workforce
- 2. If a Chillicothe R-II District employee has been placed under quarantine, they may return to work in any district buildings, if they:
  - a. do not present any symptoms of COVID-19;
  - b. do not have a positive test result for COVID-19;
  - c. wear appropriate face coverings during the duration of the work day;
  - d. maintain appropriate social distance from all Chillicothe R-II students, staff, and guests (six feet);
  - e. continue to follow the quarantine order before and after school due to the quarantine order still existing;
  - f. pass a temperature check before the work day, and the temperature must be below 100.4 degrees.
- 3. If an employee has been quarantined but is not COVID-19 positive, nor symptomatic, then they must return to work. If the employee chooses to stay home, they must use their general leave days.
- 4. If at any time, the returning essential worker presents symptoms of COVID-19, or receive a positive COVID-19 test result, then they will be required to complete their necessary quarantine period, or isolation.
